Rules for CodeFluenza2K19

1. General:

- The contest will be held on 9th March, 2019 in DBMS Laboratory (Room#206) on the 1st floor of JIS College of Engineering, Kalyani at 10:30 am onwards.
- Each team contains a single member only. Each individual will be allowed to compete separately. All contestants are required to present a valid student identification card.
- Contestants cannot bring any notes or text-books to the contest room. Blank sheets or paper will be supplied. They must carry blue/black ball point pen.
- Contestants cannot discuss amongst themselves regarding the problems they are assigned.
- Referees will be assigned to observe contestants during the contest and report any problem and/or violations of the rules to the Contest Committee.

2. Programming Environment:

- Each contestant will be allowed to use a single computer and must write and test their programs on that machine, wholly within the contest room.
- PC Compatible computers running Windows 7/8 will be used.
- Contestants may write their programs in languages **i**) C (using Dev C++), **ii**) C++ (using Dev C++) **iii**) Java (using jdk 1.6 & above in Notepad or Netbeans).
- Teams may submit only a single solution to each problem. Both the source code and the executable program for each problem must be saved inside a folder named after their Name and Mobile Number.
- Candidates may not seek hints and/or ask for leads during the contest. Each participant has to show their program after successful execution to the judges for evaluation.

3. Evaluation of Contestants' Programs

- All Candidates will be given the same set of problems to solve.
- Each problem will have a specified point value. The more difficult the problem, the more points a correct solution will receive.
- Programs will be tested by two independent judges (appointed by the Contest Committee) by running them with a set of test inputs.
- The Contest Committee will tally the scores for each candidate and publish a complete list. The candidates with the **three highest scores** will be declared. The Contest Committee's decision in all matters is final.
