

JIS College of Engineering was established in the millennium year 2000 by JIS Foundation and over the last decade grown in rapid strides to transform it into an Autonomous Institute. JIS Group is the largest educational conglomerate in the state of West Bengal and leading Private-sector Educational Group dedicated to impart demand-driven education in Science, Engineering, Technology, Management and Medical Science with highly laudable quality.

The Institution has achieved a rare feat after satisfying eligibility criterion of accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), University Grant Commission in 2009 (1st cycle) and achieving number of departmental accreditation by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) till then and moreover qualifying for Autonomous status at 2011. This enables a direct entry to the Phase-II of the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP), funded by World Bank and framework-ed by Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD).

The Institution has qualified for the World Bank Grant of Rs. 4 crore under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) Phase II in the Subcomponent 1.2, for PG and Demand- driven Research & Development & Innovation, as the only Private Self-financed institution from the State of West Bengal with three lead Universities Jadavpur University, Bengal Engineering & Science University and Calcutta University.

In a three-tier direct architecture of Nation to State to Institution, National Project Implementation Unit (NPIU) is the highest Authority in TEQIP nation-wide, whereas in the state, State Project Facilitation Unit (SPFU) leads the State level Universities and Institutions. At Institutional level, Institutional Project Management Unit (IPMU) is the principally responsible and accountable unit for comprehensive plan and execution of the TEQIP activities in complementing the regular teaching –learning process towards achieving excellence.

The Institution emerged as the best performing Institution according to the assessment of the Joint Review Mission (JRM) (Data Source: Presentation, SPFU meeting held on 16th February, 2015) as presented in Figure 1:

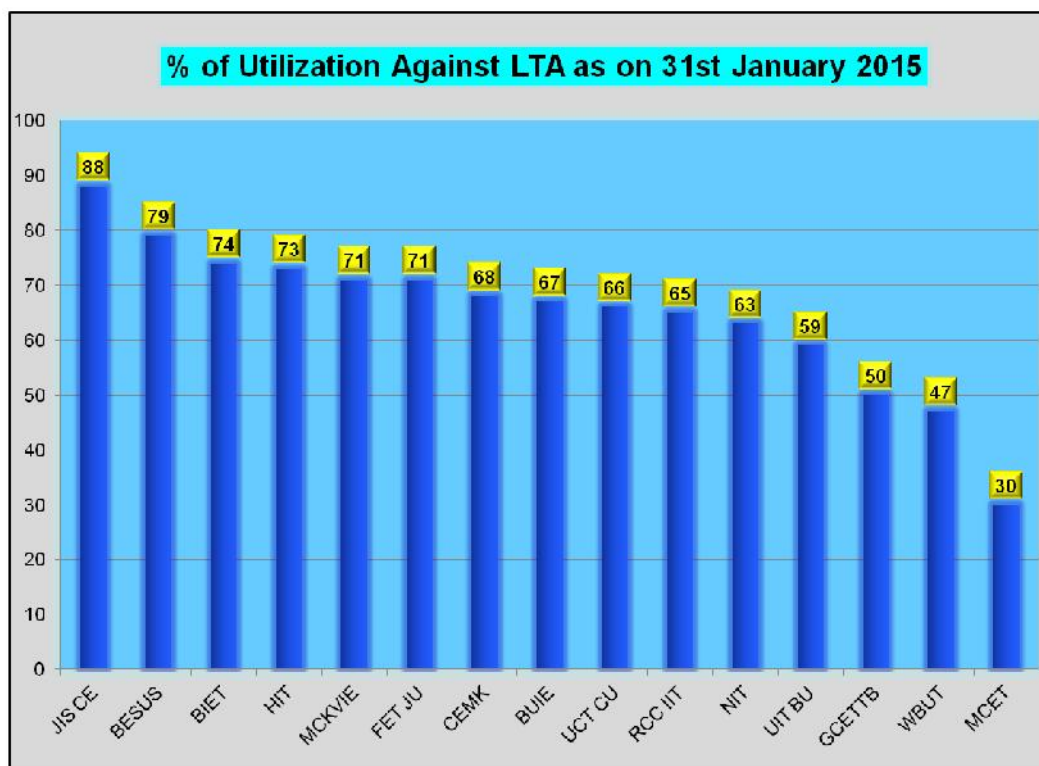

In view of the overwhelming performance of the Institution in the TEQIP Phase II Subcomponent 1.2, the Institution has been allocated an additional grant of *Rupees Two Crore* (Including Institutional Share).
