### **Proceedings of the Meeting:**

With the permission of the chair Dr. Partha Sarkar, Principal JISCE, the discussion was initiated by Dr. Sandip Ghosh with the welcome notes. At the onset Dr. Ghosh presented the Action Taken Report on the basis of last meeting minutes, and the same was approved by Dr. Sarkar.

Following major topics have been discussed by IQAC in the meeting:

### Agenda Item 1. Approval of the Deployment of Strategic Plan 2019-2024

**Discussion:** The deployment of strategic plan 2019-24 [Annexure –I] was presented and several achievements were appraised by all members.

**Resolution:** To meet all remaining targets, resolution was taken to prepare a consolidated plan for the next 5 years before next IQAC meeting.

#### Agenda Item 2. Analysis of the feedback from stakeholder for even semester

**Discussion:** The analysis of the feedback collected from the students regarding teaching learning and other facilities for the last even semester 2024 [Annexure –II] was presented and discussed.

**Resolution:** All head of the departments was advised to further improve in relevant aspects to maintain the quality education and other services. Review of library & reading room usage was clarified. It was advised to increase the no of student participation in the next feedback session through mentors. It was also discussed, that in future a process of student selection may apply for eligibility regarding feedback process.

#### Agenda Item 3: Review of faculty feedback for even semester

**Discussion:** The teaching learning feedback collected for all courses across the department was discussed. **Resolution:** All departmental HODs were advised to conduct separate meetings to decide further course of action regarding courses with relatively poor feedback.

## Agenda Item 4. Result Analysis for even semester

**Discussion:** Result Analysis for the Even Semester examination was presented [Annexure-III] and it was discussed that there has been improvement in comparison to previous year.

**Resolution:** Head of the Department of basic Science was advised to arrange 3 extra classes /week for 1st year Physics and Maths for lateral students and lately admitted 1st year students.

#### Agenda Item 5. Review of requirement- Building, Laboratories, Library, Faculty & Staff

**Discussion:** Review of departmental requirements regarding Building, Laboratories, Library, Faculty & Staff was done. New appointments and resignations happened in various departments were presented. Librarian Ms. Basu, confirmed about that some of the books for new department CST and CSE(AIML) have been delivered. **Resolution:** All departments should take care of all the requirements time to time and place in front of purchase committee after passing all the requirements in departmental academic committee meetings.

# Agenda Item 6. Review of Extra Curricular, Co-Curricular, Social Services, extension and Student Club activities

**Discussion:** Various extra academic, co-curricular, Social service through NSS and other club activities held in the 2024 were presented in the meeting.

**Resolution:** The report was appreciated and it was advised to continue various Social Services and Student Club activities on respective occasions.

### Agenda Item 7. Analysis of Admission status

**Discussion:** Detailed analysis of the present status of Admission 2024 was presented [Annexure–III]. A location wise admission analysis revealed that admitted students mostly belong to adjacent districts. A downfall in admission from Tripura was also observed, while admission from Midnapur district was found to increase. **Resolution:** Admission team was advised to enhance their reach by conducting collaborative programs with various schools in different districts.

#### Agenda Item 8. Review of Alumni Activity, Conduction of Alumni Meet

**Discussion:** Alumni activities held in the year 2024 were presented and discussed.

**Resolution:** It was advised to increase no of alumni interaction to build a strong alumni network useful in getting industry oriented inputs.

#### Agenda Item 9. Review of NIRF ranking of current year & recommendation for subsequent years

**Discussion**: It was reported that JIS College of Engineering has achieved a rank band of 201-300 in NIRF ranking 2024. All concerned members of the NIRF committee were appraised. A detailed analysis was presented by Dr. Soumyabrata Saha, HOD-IT, JISCE.

**Resolution:** A New NIRF committee was proposed and approved in the meeting.

#### Agenda Item 10. Review of NBA status of various departments

**Discussion:** Review of NBA status of various departments was done.

**Resolution:** Departments which are going to face the NBA visit, were advised to complete all of their necessary preparations.

## Agenda Item 11. Progress regarding IDP framework as per UGC guidelines

**Discussion:** Detailed understanding of the framework is necessary.

**Resolution:** A separate committee to be formulated which will take care of the IDP framework.

- I. Academic Audit of the institution will be held after Durga Puja vacation.
- II. IQAC was reconstituted and the new committee was presented in the meeting by the Chairman of IQAC. Newly suggested representatives from students and Alumni have been discussed.
- III. Annual Cultural Fest 'maJIStic 2K24' was organized on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> April 2024 which hosted include inter-college and inter-school competitions.
- IV. International Conference ICEMSSED 2024 was held on 26-27th April 2024.
- V. BME Department have received a research grant from AICTE in September 2024. A tie up between BME Department and GNIDSR has been established.

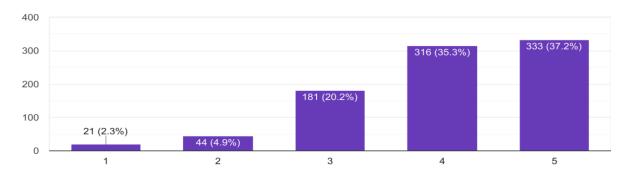


Rate the curriculum and syllabus in terms of modernization and industry orientedness 895 responses



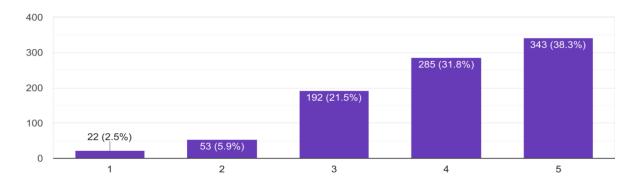
Rate the overall Teaching Learning process in terms of regularity of class, teaching method, subject understanding

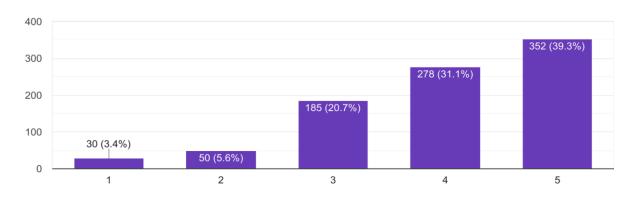


Rate the overall Teaching Learning process in terms of content delivery by faculties, innovative approaches

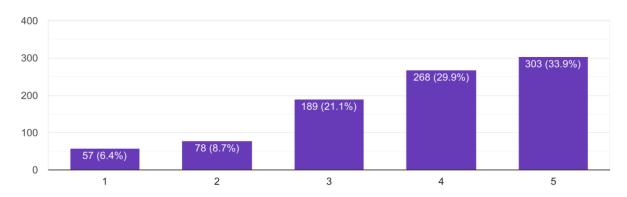

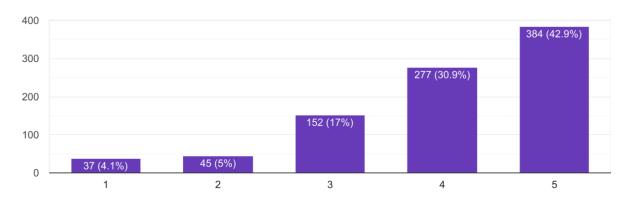
Rate the overall Teaching Learning process in terms of laboratory infrastructure 895 responses



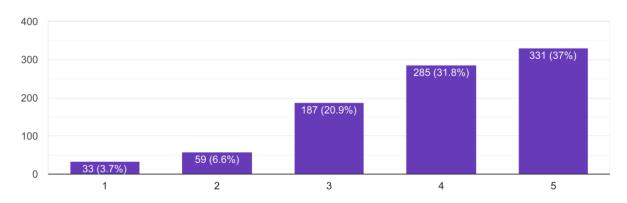
Rate the overall Teaching Learning process in terms of training and internship opportunities 895 responses



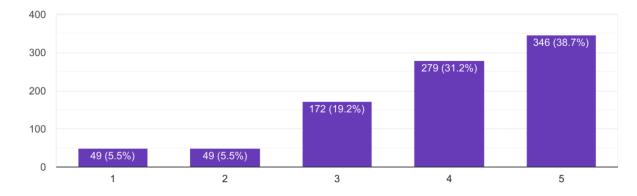
Rate the student support system in terms of mentorship, interaction and guidance 895 responses



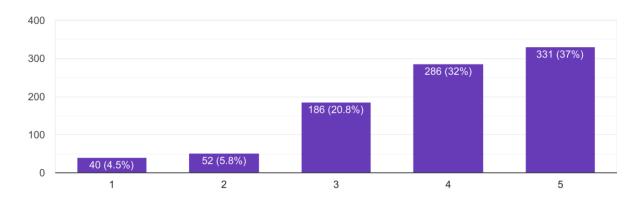
Rate the student support system in terms of lecture notes, Lecture videos and guidance 895 responses



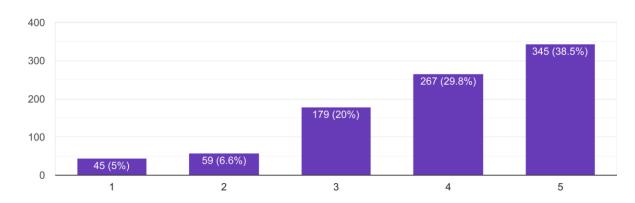
Rate the student support system in terms of Library and reading room access  $895\,\mathrm{responses}$ 



# Rate the various Club activities of JISCE in terms of programs conducted $895\,\mathrm{responses}$

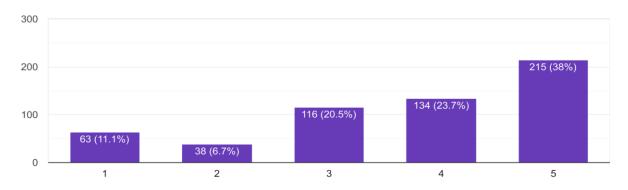


# Rate the sports activities of JISCE in terms of events conducted $895\,\mathrm{responses}$

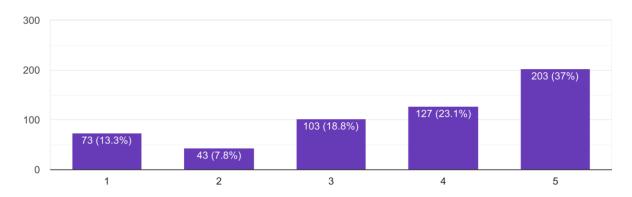


# Rate the hostel living at JISCE in terms of room, security and internet service (if you are a hostel boarder)

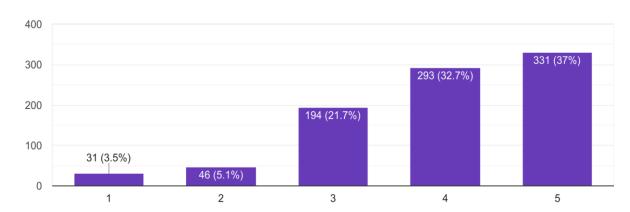




Rate the hostel living at JISCE in terms of food and other facilities (if you are a hostel boarder) 549 responses

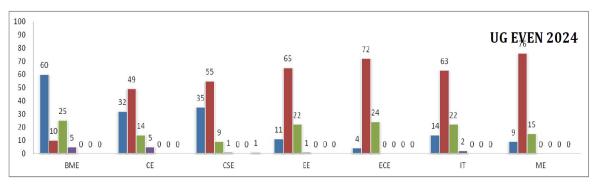


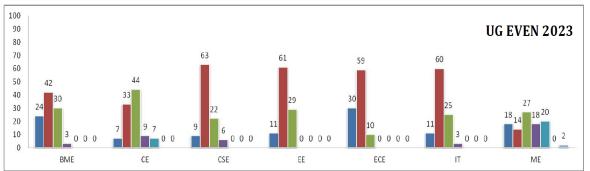
Rate the overall campus of JISCE in terms of campus  $\,$  ambiance and administrative support  $\,$  895 responses

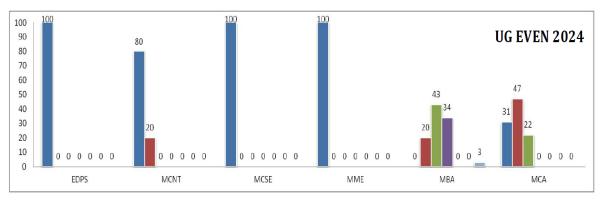


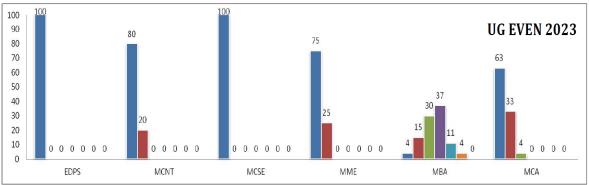

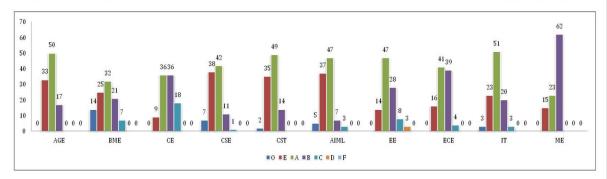


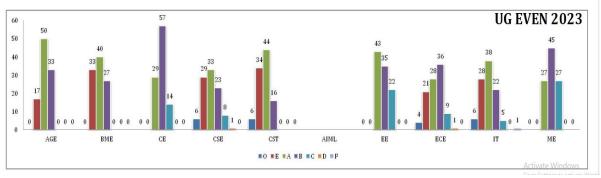




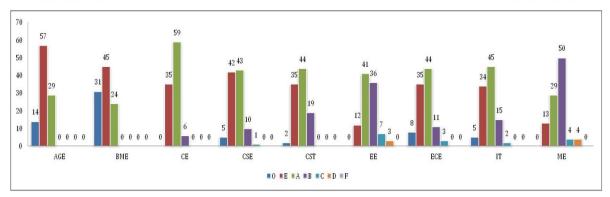


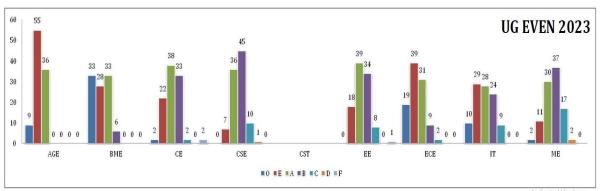




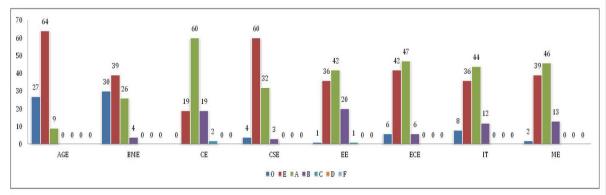


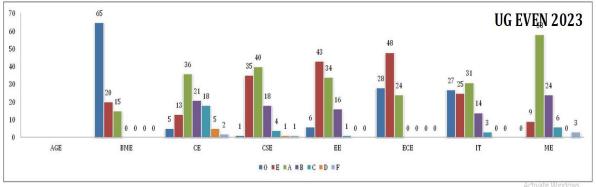
4TH SEMESTER UG EVEN 2024



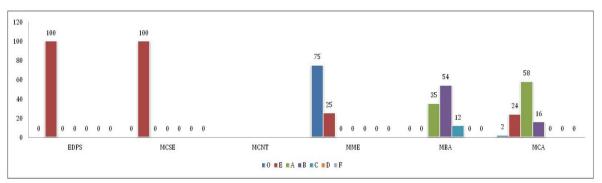


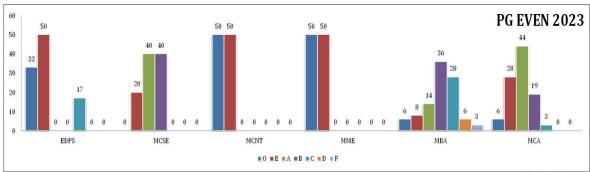






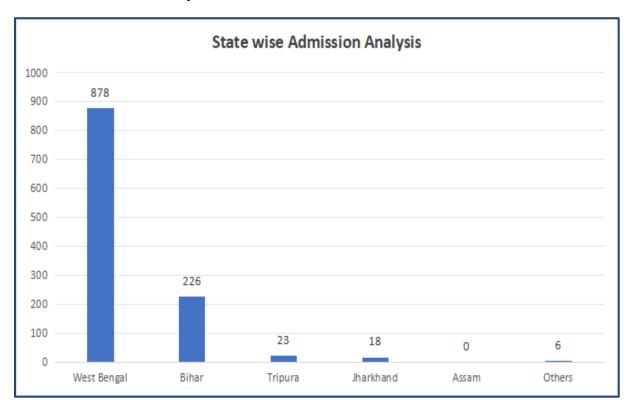
2ND SEMESTER PG EVEN 2024



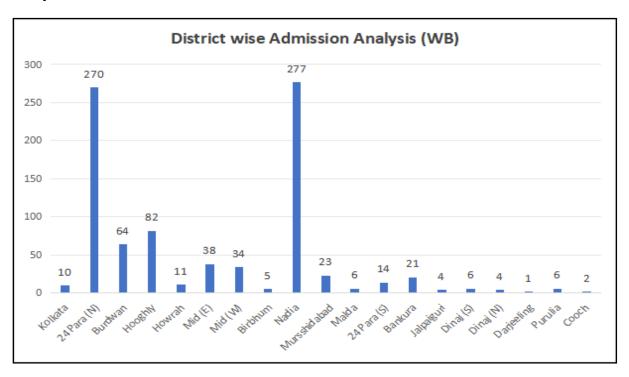
